#### ENGINEERING QUALIFICATIONS BASED SELECTION

The Shiawassee County Drain Commissioner (SCDC) is utilizing a Qualification Based Selection process to solicit and select an engineering consultant to complete a 2023 Non-point Source (NPS) Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) Project Plan for submittal to the Michigan's Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy (EGLE) for consideration for future funding

## Deadline to respond: Tuesday, January 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2023 at 4:00 p.m. Submittal requirements:

- Be brief, 10 page maximum (including experience and resumes)
- Include company information including team member information and roles
- Provide experience with CWSRF and County Drain Code processes
- List number of CWSRF NPS. CWSRF and DWRF project plans completed with client information
- Provide any familiarity with projects listed on attachment 1
- Make a definitive statement that your firm can complete the required Project Plan following current EGLE guidelines in the timeline stated by EGLE for FY 2023-2024 funding and provide any concerns.
- Provide a list of any potential conflicts of interest in performing this assignment including representation of any communities, other agencies, or overlapping jurisdictions within the County.

The Drain Commissioner will use a point system to rank the submittals. The point system is as follows:

Overall Firm and Staff Familiarity with the CWSRF Project Planning Process 50 points Experience with County Drain Code Processes 30 points Knowledge and familiarity with drains listed on attachment 1 10 Points Ability to deliver the Project Plan by May 1, 2023 10 Points

The Drain Commissioner reserves the right to request follow up information, conduct interviews, and/or waive irregularities in the statement of qualifications submitted.
