SHIAWASSEE COUNTY PARK RULES

- 1. Parks open at 8am and close at sunset.
- 2. The person reserving a park pavilion is responsible for leaving the area clean and disposing of trash in the proper receptacles. Failure to do so may result in an additional cleanup fee.
- 3. No person, except authorized personnel, shall remove, cut, deface, or destroy any vegetation, whether alive or dead.
- 4. No fires are allowed except in the fireplaces and grills provided.
- 5. No person shall hunt, trap, catch, wound, or kill any bird or other animals upon any land or water owned by the County. Fishing that follows applicable state laws is allowed.
- 6. No motor vehicle of any kind shall operate on any park grounds, except on park roads or designated areas.
- 7. No person shall act in a manner that disturbs the peace, quiet, or tranquility of the area, such as loud radios, music, vehicles, or other public disturbances.
- 8. No person shall fire, discharge, or have in his or her possession any fireworks or any other explosive substance in or onto County property.
- 9. No firearms, bow, crossbow, or slingshot shall be discharged in or onto County property. Possession of a firearm, bow, crossbow, or slingshot must follow applicable state law.
- 10. It is unlawful to litter County property or discharge any solid or liquid within the boundaries of the park which may result in the pollution of the ground or water.
- 11. No person shall sell, use, or have in their possession any alcoholic beverage, drug, or narcotic.

Pursuant to MCL 46.364, a person who violates these rules is guilty of a misdemeanor.

NOW, THERFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commission hereby adopts and approves the County Park Rules as attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Park Rules shall become effective only after each of the following occurs: (1) the County Park Rules are approved by the Shiawassee County Board of Commissioners, (2) no less than nine (9) days have passed from the date of this Resolution, (3) the County Park Rules are published for two consecutive weeks (once per week) in a newspaper or newspapers of general circulation in Shiawassee County, and (4) a copy of the County Park Rules are posted at the gate or entrance to each facility or area to which they will apply.
