City of Durand

MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the City of Durand, Michigan be increased by 3.7169 mills (\$3.72 per thousand dollars of taxable value) for a period of ten (10) years, from 2024 through 2033, as new additional millage in excess of the limitation imposed by Michigan Compiled Laws section 211.34d, to restore City Charter millage authorization previously approved by the electors as reduced by operation of the Headlee amendment, to provide funds for municipal operating purposes, including, but not limited to, police, fire and emergency medical services? It is estimated that 3.7169 mills would raise approximately \$295,000 when first levied in 2024.

SINKING FUND MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the building and site sinking fund millage that expires with the 2023 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate of 1.9588 mills (\$1.9588 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) which may be assessed against all property in Owosso Public Schools, Shiawassee County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 5 years, 2024 to 2028, inclusive, to continue to provide for a sinking fund for the construction or repair of school buildings and all other purposes authorized by law; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2024 is approximately \$1,338,906 (this is a renewal of millage that expires with the 2023 tax levy)?
