

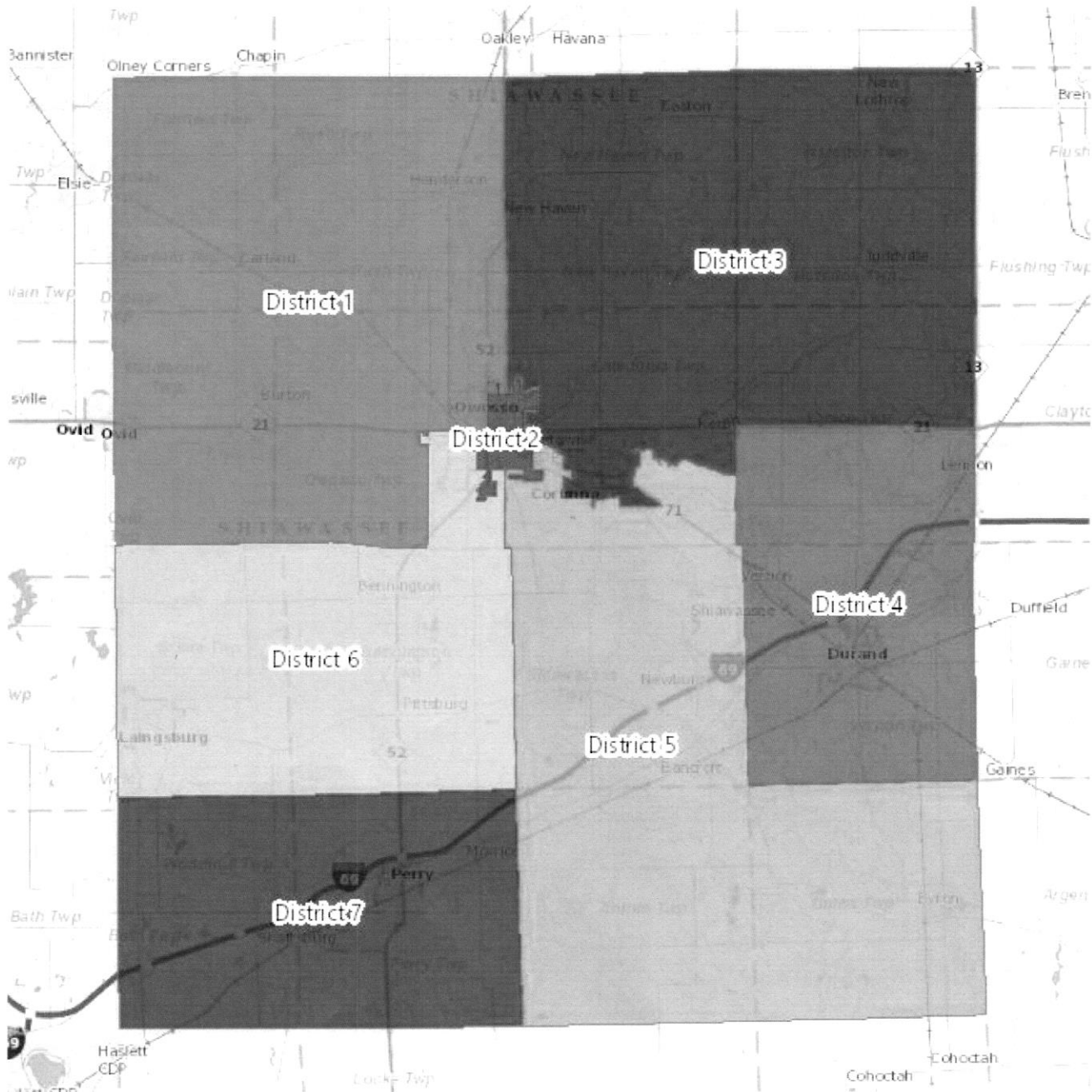

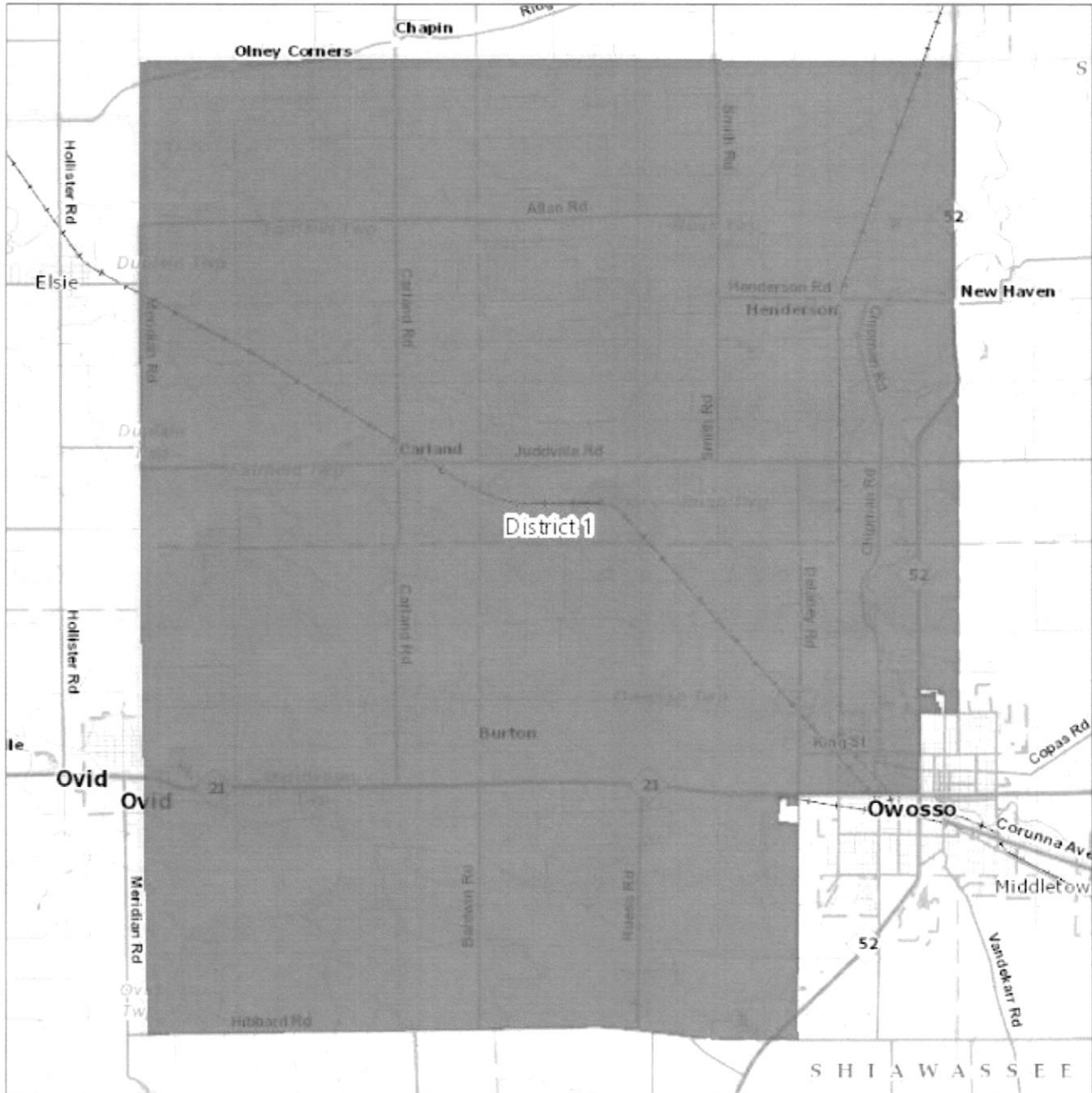

Shiawassee County District Map



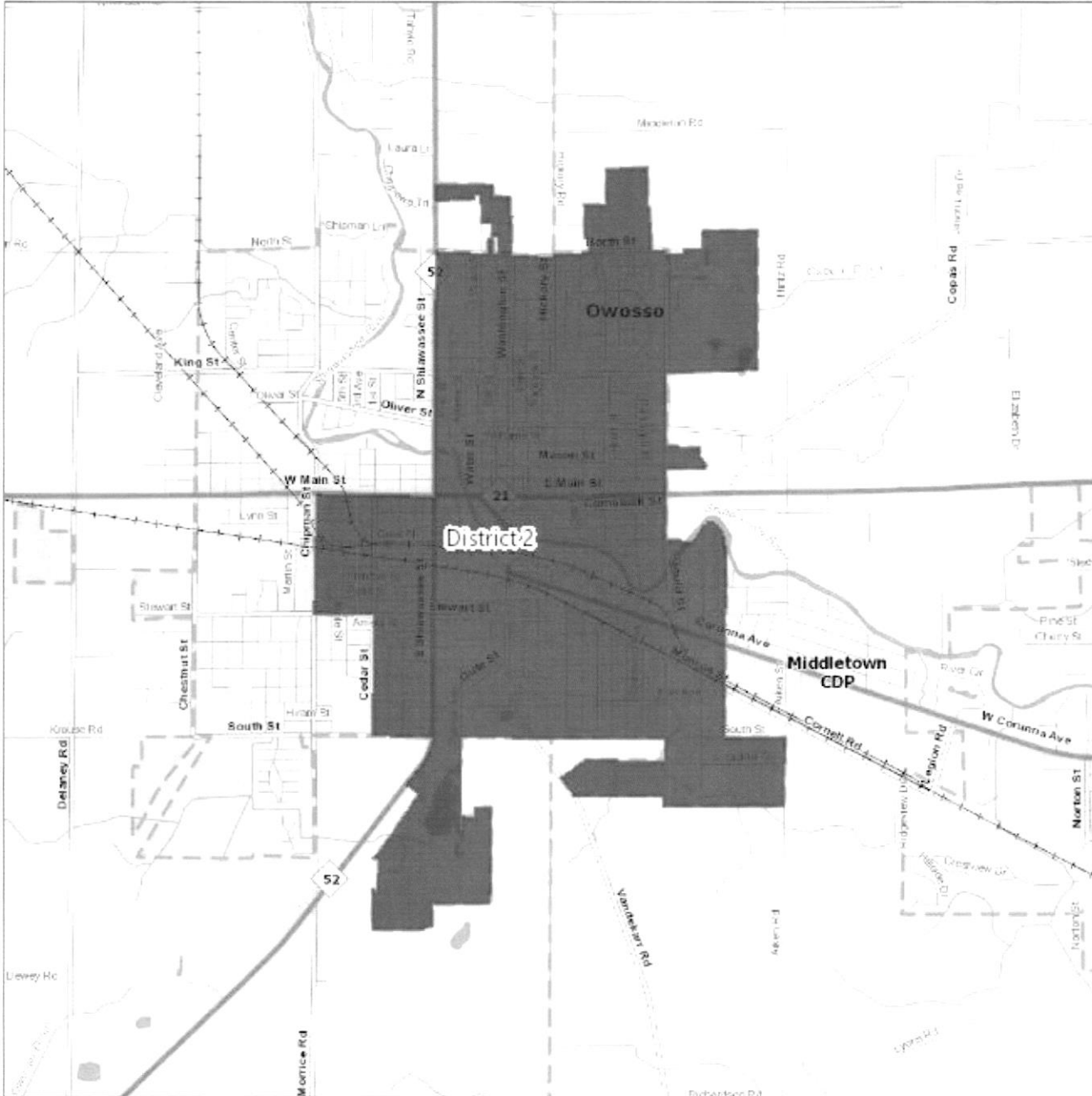

District 1 - population 9,688



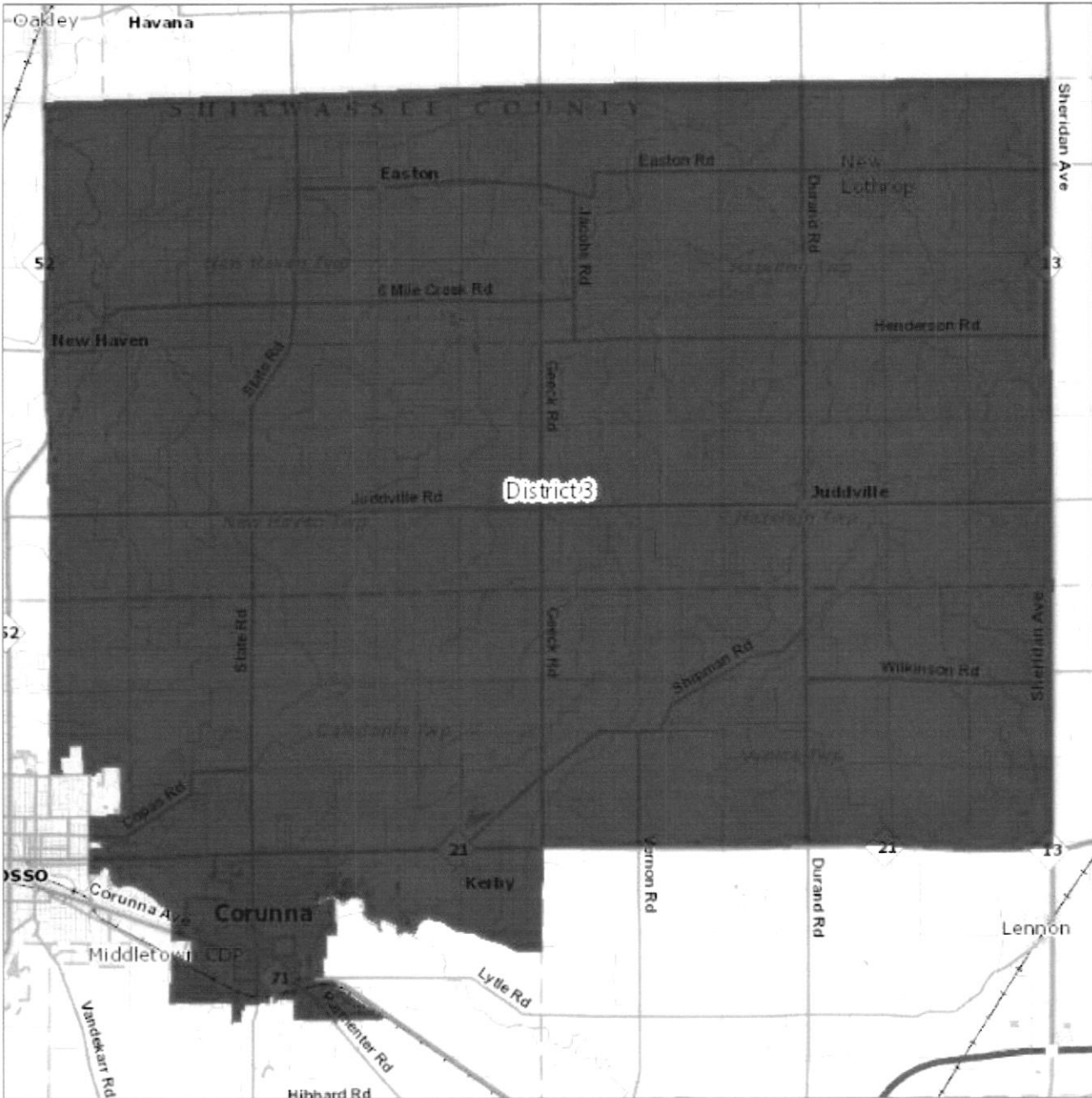

District 2 - population 9,675



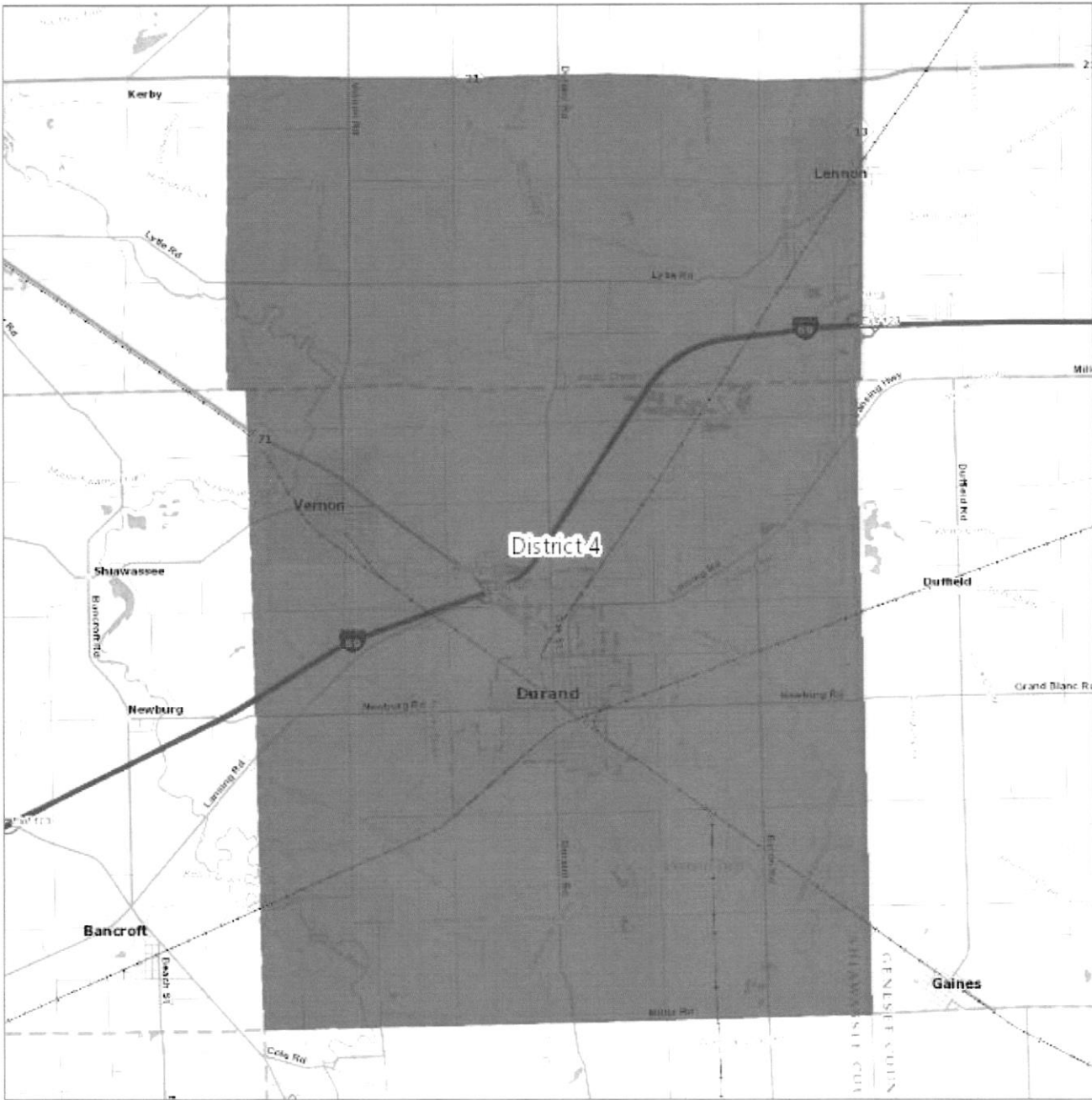

District 3 - population 9,590



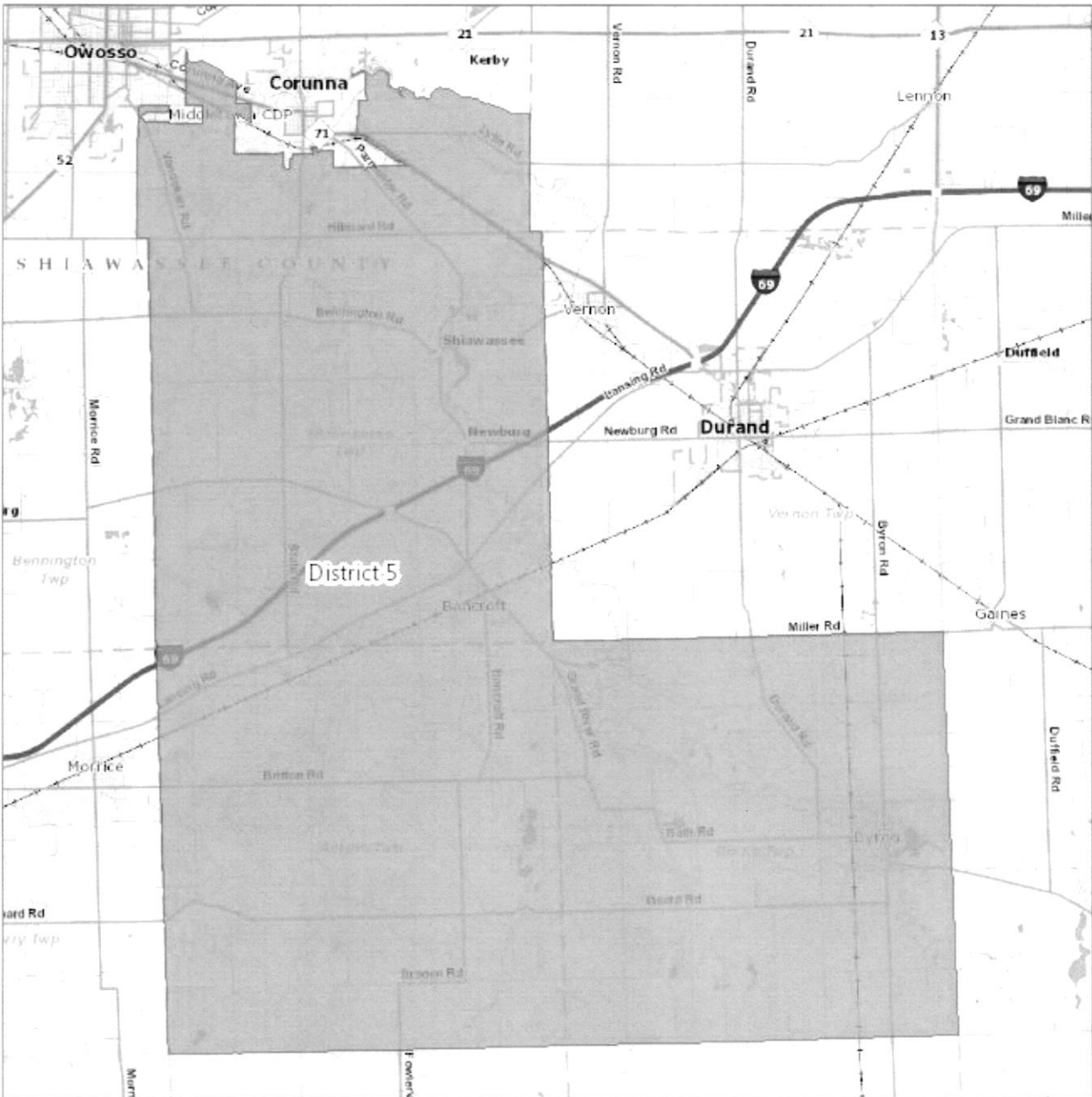

District 4 - population 9,420



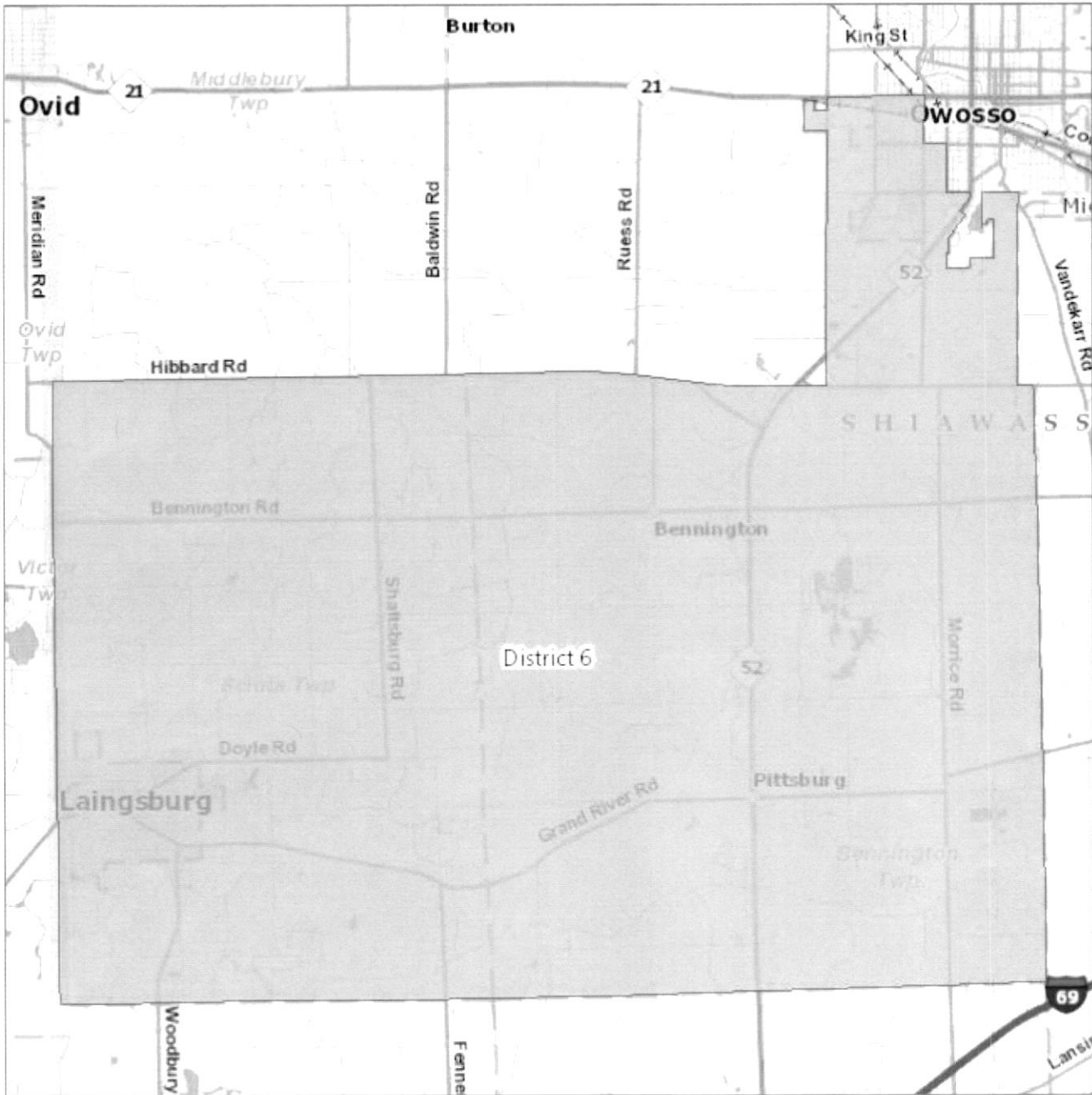

District 5 - population 10,006



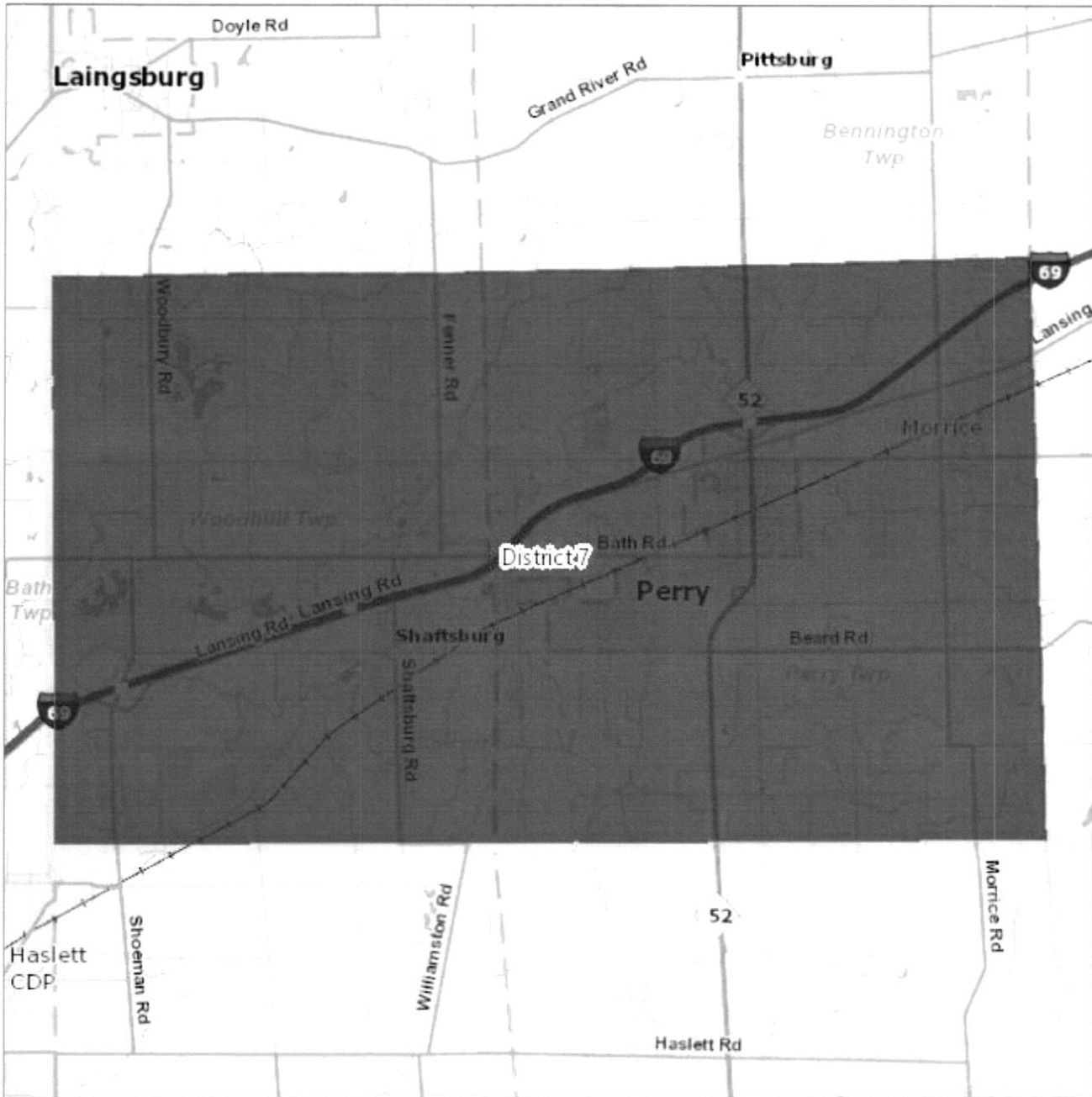
