

At the regular meeting of the Shiawassee County Board of Commissioners held on Wednesday, February 14, 2024 in the Commissioner Chambers, Surbeck Building, Corunna, Michigan:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Brodeur at 5:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Invocation was offered by Commissioner Webster.

Roll call found Commissioners Webster, Holzhausen, Garber, Howard, Emery and Chairman Brodeur present. Commissioner Johnson excused.

It was moved by Commissioner Howard, seconded by Commissioner Garber to approve the agenda as presented. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Howard, seconded by Commissioner Webster to approve the minutes of the January 10, 2023 Board of Commissioners meeting. Motion carried.

It was moved by Commissioner Webster, seconded by Commissioner Howard to approve the refilling of a Road Patrol Deputy position due to retirement. Motion carried with the following roll call vote of 6 yeas: Commissioners Webster, Holzhausen, Garber, Howard, Emery and Chairman Brodeur. 0 nays.

It was moved by Commissioner Webster, seconded by Commissioner Emery to approve the minutes from the February 13, 2024 Public Safety and Courts Committee meeting. Motion carried.

Chairman Brodeur reported on the Land Bank is still doing good work and Community Mental Health is going well.

County Coordinator Dr. Boggs reported on the public comment and the clean-up of dead animals, the recycling plan will be public meetings and will start in a couple of months, 2023 book will be closed; auditors will be here to present in May, ARPA money remaining is for District Court and the jail, the 35th Circuit Court Union Contract will be forthcoming for March and the County will be closed on Monday, February 19th for President's Day.
